Students are expected to dress in a manner that is supportive of a positive learning environment. Students are strongly encouraged to wear selected uniforms Monday through Thursday. Fridays are reserved for jeans and spirit wear.

<p>Bottom- Black or Khaki Pants, shorts (straight leg or pleated)</p> <p>Top- White or yellow Shirt- Collared polo style, turtleneck or oxford style No graphic designs</p> <p>Shoes Solid black, brown or white</p> <p>Socks are to be worn with uniform at all times</p> <p>Belt Black or brown Buckle approximately 2 inches</p> <p>No emblem or oversized</p>	<p>Bottom- Black or Khaki Pants, shorts, skorts, skirts,</p> <p>Top- White or yellow Shirt-Collared polo style, turtleneck or oxford style No graphic designs</p> <p>Shoes Solid black, brown or white</p> <p>Socks are to be worn with uniform at all times Girls-leggings should be ankle length Socks/tights/leggings Black or white</p> <p>Belt Black or brown Buckle approximately 2 inches</p> <p>No emblem or oversized</p> <p>**When arms are hanging down to their sides, skirts or shorts should hang longer than the longest finger tip</p>

Boys and girls pants must fit on the waist and/or be worn with a belt.

<p>Optional: Blazer (black) Cardigan sweater(black, yellow or white) Tie (black, yellow)</p>	<p>The following articles of clothing are not to be worn or used at Centerville:</p> <p>Skirts, shorts or pants that are inappropriate (i.e. too short or sagging). Hats, visors, bandannas, sweatbands, sunglasses, flip flop sandals Other appearance that is deemed distracting or disruptive is unacceptable.</p>
