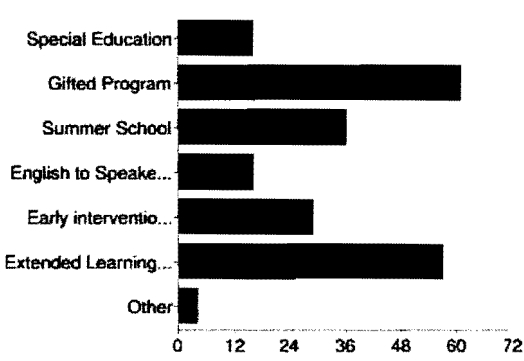

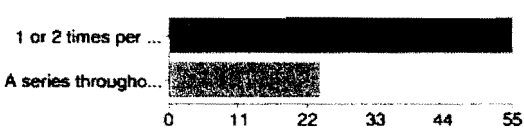
### 1. I would like to know more about these programs in my school...

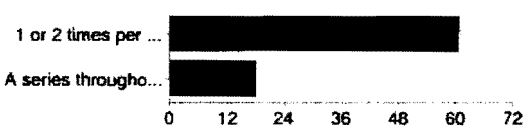

### 2. How often would you like workshops on - Reading-Literature



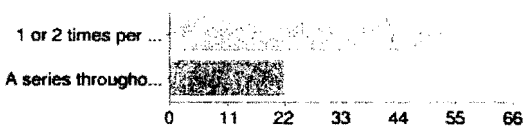

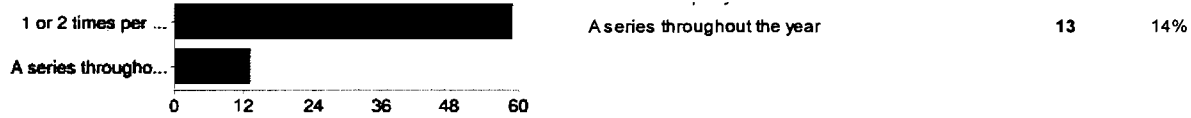

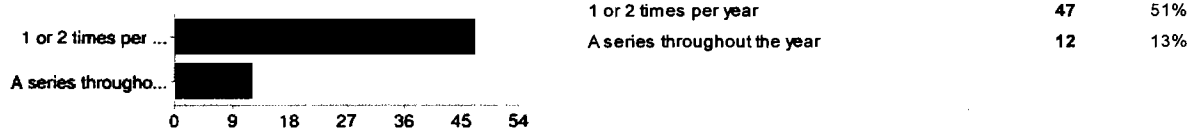

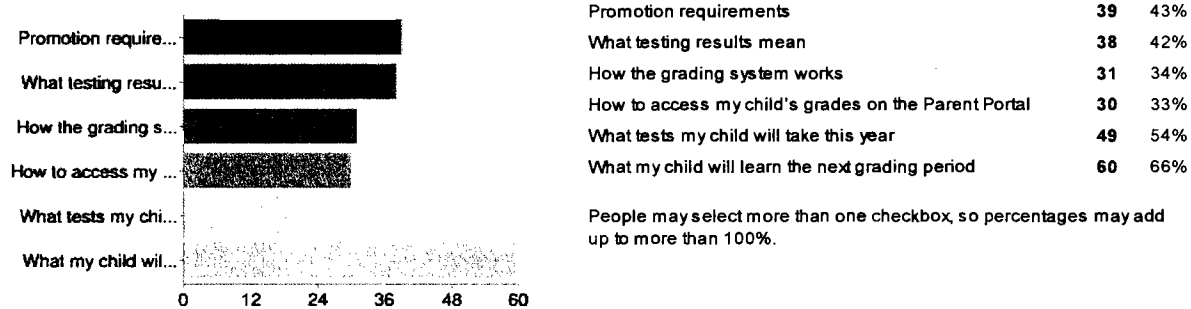

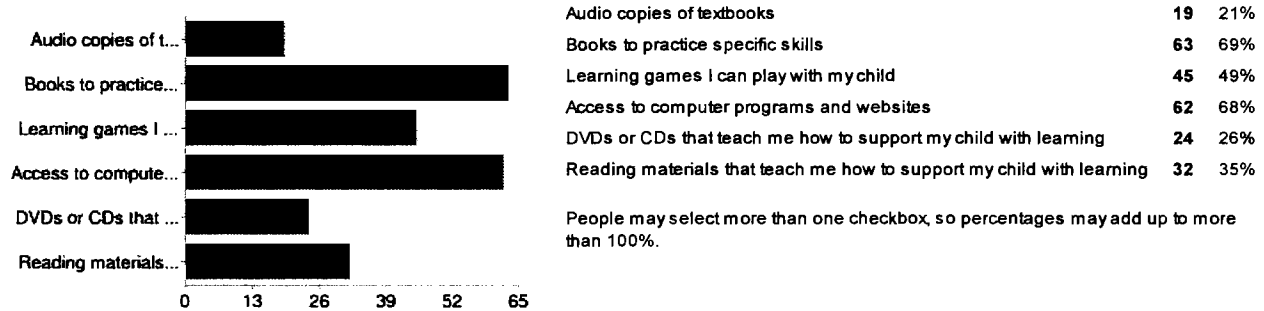
2. How often would you like workshops on - Technology



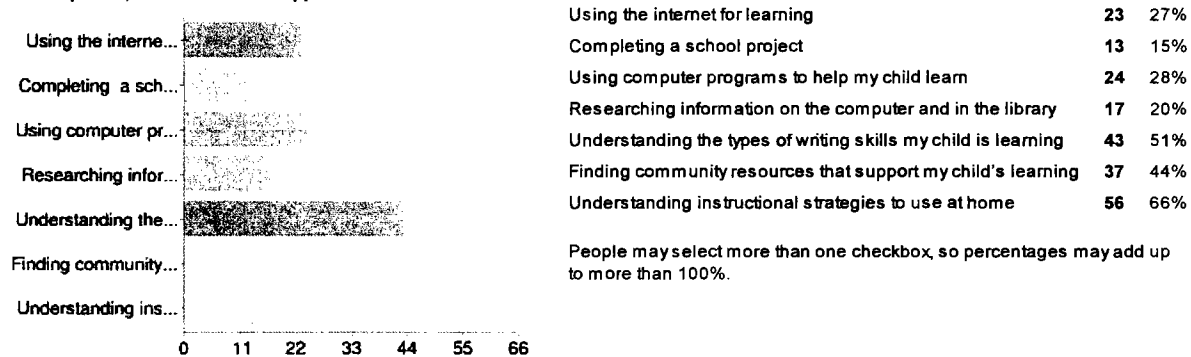
3. What information would help you keep up with your child's progress?



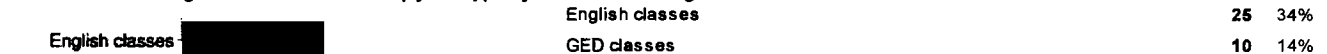

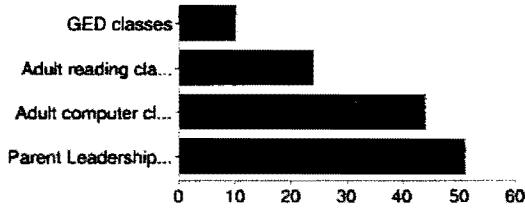


5. As a parent, I need the most support with...



6. What adult learning classes would most help you support your child's learning?

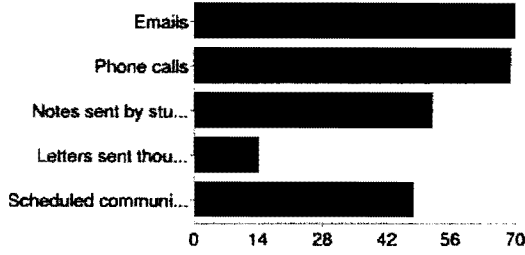

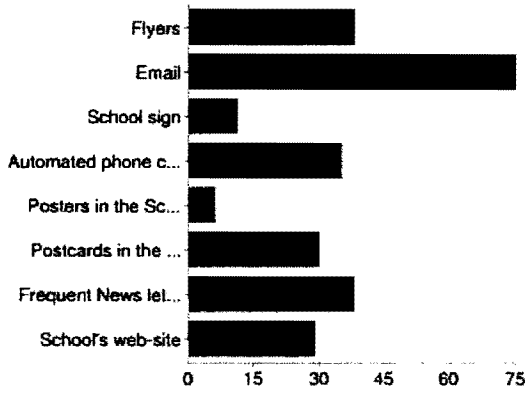
7. What are the best ways for your child's TEACHERS to contact you?

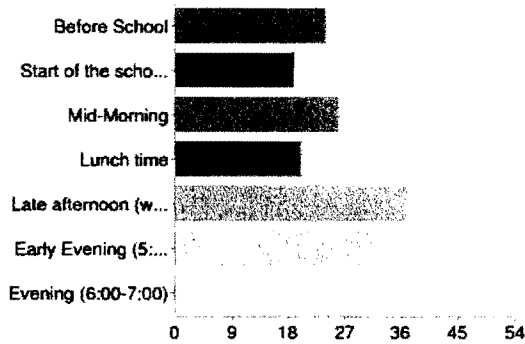

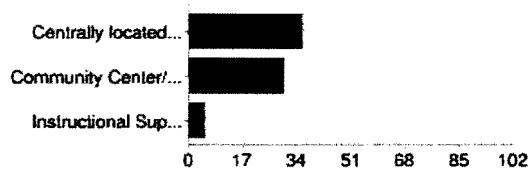

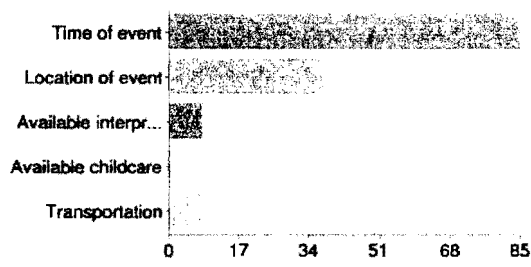

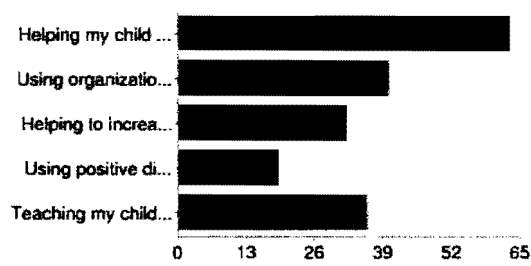
11. What affects your ability to attend conferences, workshops and other school events?

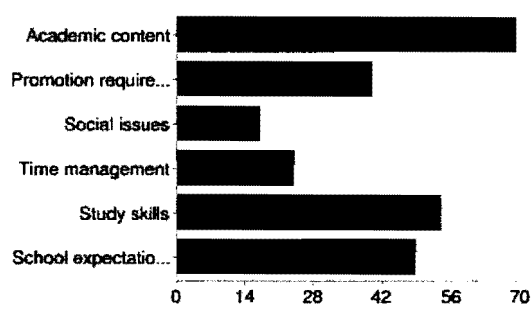
12. To better support my child academically, I would like more information about...

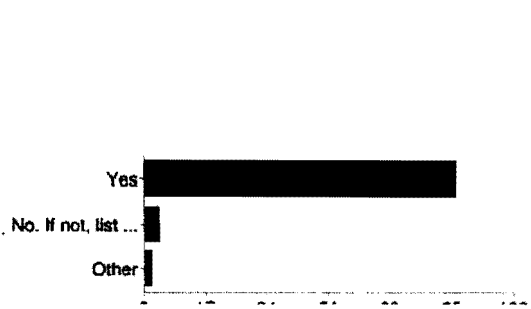
13. As your child moves to the next school level, on which topics about the new school do you need more information?
